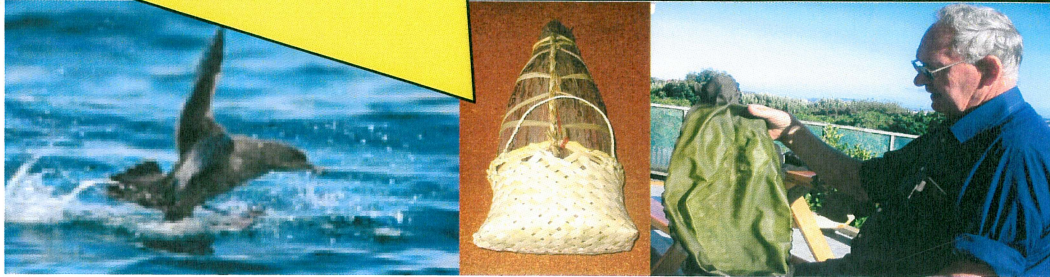


Attention: Te Reo Maori, Home Economics, Social Studies Teachers and Librarian
